Duty Club for Saturday Club Competition is to supply a CRO (& Fire Officer) and is responsible for range clearance, setting and retrieving flags and bin clearance.

TARGET INSTALLATION - For Long Range Targets, club members to gather in LRG 45mins before start of shooting for combined installation of all targets. For Short Range Targets, clubs may install their targets in their own time but should be finished no later than 30min prior to start of shooting.

For Team Shooting the MDRA will supply the CRO and range clearance. Duty Club shall liaise with CRO for setting and retrieving flags. Other duties shall be as noted above for regular Saturday Club Competition.

When there is a team shoot on Sunday, the Saturday Duty Club is asked to leave the flags out and bring them in after the shoot.

Table with columns: Date, Range, Duty Clubs, and target positions (B1-C2). Lists shooting events with detailed target assignments and duty club responsibilities.

ELECTRONIC TARGETS - As part of Range Clearance and Setup, Duty Club shall:

- (1) Take trailer to between BX & C1 on firing mound, set out comms spine cable, set up Generator or Power to Magazine. (BUT DO NOT TURN ON)
(2) Collect Target Cables & Transmitter Box from Magazine and take to Gallery. Supervise installation of targets to correct positions with all cables linked, BEFORE powering up system, set aerial & TURN ON and check tell-tale LEDs on all targets
(3) On Mound connect spine cable to trailer, check generator fuel level and then POWER UP system.

At conclusion of shoot, collect spine cable and ensure all equipment is stowed in trailer and return it to Magazine. Ensure all targets correctly stored back in shed and it is locked. Collect cables and Transmitter Box and return to Magazine.

The Transmitter Box is to be connected to mains power for charging.

EACH CLUB is to collect and connect the Monitors for their allocated target positions, and once system powered up select CORRECT distance.

At conclusion of shooting EACH CLUB is to return Monitors and Cables into trailer.

NB - Target and Monitor Cables are NOT to be coiled but halved up and loose knotted before being stored.
